Next week's topic: Where we live.

The children will be asked to learn their house number and road name and the area they live in (e.g. Croydon, South Norwood, South/ London etc). We will find out what an address is and why we need one (where our home is, where our family live, for deliveries, post, visitors, in case we get lost etc). We will try to look for places such as parks, rivers, roads etc. on a simple map. We'll look at the many types of buildings in our local area. We will try to find our school and other addresses on Google Earth and draw our own giant map. We will also use shapes to construct houses and buildings.

Things to do at home...

When you read with your child:

- discuss the different types of homes there are, modelling interesting vocabulary and longer sentences as you talk. (houses, detached, terraced, semi-detached, flats and bungalows)
- do the buildings we live in look the same as a school building? A shop? A sports centre? A library? What is the same/not same (size, types of windows, doors, roof etc)
- When you are out and about draw attention to common signs and print in the environment (eg simple road/pavement signs, shop logos, adverts, notices, car registration letters/numbers etc)
