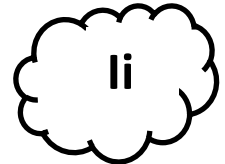

Tips to do at home...

The greatest asset you can equip your child with is good language and understanding. When you read with your child always discuss the story and pictures with them, modelling interesting vocabulary and well-structured sentences as you talk. Ask them questions throughout, not only to gauge their understanding, but also to help them practice giving clear explanations and to organise their thoughts. Never correct their sentences just repeat/model the sentence back to them correctly.
