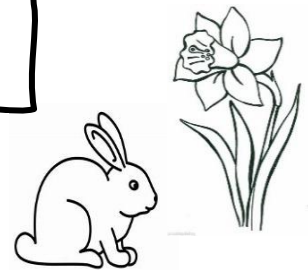

Happy Easter!



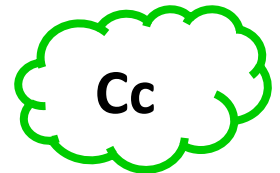
Have a wonderful break 😊

Things to do at home over the holidays

- Collect objects beginning with the same sound and put on a tray or in a box. Name the objects for your child, stressing the initial sound and ask them to repeat it after you. Cover the objects with a tea towel and take an object away. Can your child remember the missing object? Change the game with different initial sounds
- Please begin to practice sounding out CVC words with the children who will be going up to reception eg C-A-T, H-O-T, S-I-T etc
- General maths 1:1 accurate counting, knowing that the last number said is the quantity counted. If your child is ready ask them to count 2 groups to find the total to introduce them to addition.
- Please practice name writing using a good tripod pencil grip and using correct letter formation, ESPECIALLY the children that are going up to reception 😊
