#### Communication, Language and Literacy, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Physical Development, Literacy, Maths, Understanding the World, Expressive Arts and Design

In Reception this week, we have continued our Autumn themed and taken learning to the enchanted woodland where we met Stick Man. The children love this familiar Julia Donaldson story and enjoyed a range of wonderful enchanted activities. The children started the week watching the animated story on the BBC. Following this the children have enjoyed creating their own Stick Men, using the story to create wonderful writing and using real sticks to create art work.

In Monster Phonics this week the children have been learning the sounds "ch", "sh", "th (v)" and "ng". This has included how to say the sound, write the sound and thinking of words that begin with that sound. During Monster Phonics we model blending CVC words using dots and dashes, this encourages the children to hear each individual sound and see how letters blend into words.

In Write Away, we have continued with our daily letter formation, focusing on this week's letters. We have also extended our Write Away session linking them to our topic. This week the children have been encouraged to write sentences and words such as 'Stick Man is lost.' The children have also enjoyed creating their own stick family, thinking about who lives in their home. We are very impressed with the care the children are taking to present their work neatly, forming their letters correctly and listening

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carefully to include the sounds in each word.

This week, our Maths carpet sessions were focused on numbers 7-10. This includes using concrete resources such as counters and cubes to represent the number. We have also looked at how to form numbers 7-10. Over the weekend go on a number hunt and see how many number 7,8,9 and 10 you can find.
