In Reception this week, it was Musical Week and children had a fantastic time listening to pieces of music from different parts of the world and analysing the tempo of the songs. Children spend a long time rehearsing for the Christmas production alongside their friends from Year 1. They have all impressed us with their beautiful singing and acting and we are looking forward to sharing the joy with you.

In Monster Phonics, this week the children have been recapping the sounds that they have learnt so far and have also been learning the sounds "th" and "oo". This has included how to say the sound, write the sound and thinking of words that begin with that sound. During Monster Phonics we model blending CVC words using dots and dashes, this encourages the children to hear each individual sound and see how letters blend into words.

In Write Away, we have continued with our daily letter formation, focusing on this week's letters. We have also extended our Write Away session linking them to our topic. This week the children have been encouraged to write sentences and words to describe the sounds that some musical instruments make. The children have also enjoyed creating their own stick family, thinking about who lives in their home. We are very impressed with the care the children are taking to present their work neatly, forming their letters correctly and listening carefully to include the sounds in each word.

This week, in Maths we have recapped numbers from 0 to 10. Children have consolidated their learning through using concrete objects as cubes and counters and through lots of interactive Maths games.
