### Communication, Language and Literacy, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Physical Development, Literacy, Maths, Understanding the World, Expressive Arts and Design

This week the children have enjoyed lots of Christmas and festive fun. The children have enjoyed making their Christmas cards, calendars, and their Christmas decoration for their Christmas trees, all of which will be going home next week. The beginning of the week was a very busy, recording the Christmas nativity. The children spoke and sung beautifully, and we can't wait to share the video with you next week.



All the children continue to make a huge effort in their Monster Phonics Lessons. This week we focussed on the sound- 'OO', this sound is made by 'cool blue' from monster phonics. The children enjoyed listening to the story of Jack and the Beanstalk by Monster Phonics, which focussed on the words that have the 'oo'.

The children are being encouraged to recognise the individual sounds and to blend them into a word, in order to read them.

In Write Away this week, we have based our writing on our festive theme, naming Christmas objects and encouraging the children to form simple sentence such as 'I am a ...' (based on the Christmas production) and 'The tree is big.'

In Maths Mastery this week, the children have been learning about addition and subtraction telling a story, for example 'first there are 5 dogs in the park, then 3 more arrive. Then there are 8 dogs in the park.' Telling stories in this way helps to give the maths meaning and helps the children to understanding maths in the real world. The use of concrete objects such as cubes has helped to solidify the children's knowledge.

Can you put these oo words into sentences?

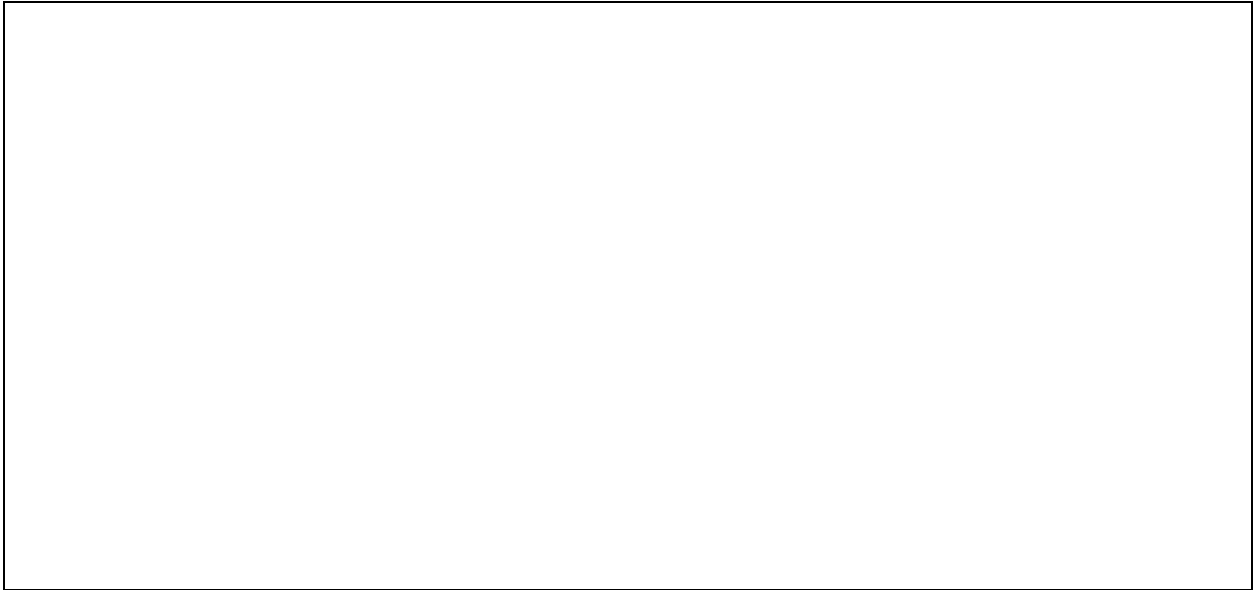
