This week our topic in Reception has been 'People Who Help Us'. The children have had a great time learning about the emergency services and the help they provide.

The children enjoyed taking part in activities focusing on hospitals and our body parts, eye exams at the opticians, dentists and healthy teeth and teachers who help us at school. The children have produced some fantastic work which has impressed all the adults.

We have also been focusing on healthy, independent lunch times. We are encouraging the children to hold their knife and fork correctly and to try and cut their food by themselves. The children are also encouraged to understand why healthy choices are important at lunch times.

In Maths, this week the children in Robin class have focused on Money, adding different coins together to find the total. This is a great way to deepen the children's skill of counting beyond 10 and adding two numbers to find a total. In Wren class, the children have recapped number bonds to 10 and have also learnt about Money, through practical activities and interactive games on the IWB and iPad.



In Phonics, both groups are now recapping the sounds they have learnt this year. The children have been writing sentences by dictation, reading stories and playing interactive games. It is very important that the children now read every day at home and also practise writing using the sounds they have learnt.

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Weekend Activities: As a weekend activity, draw a picture of a special person in your life who you believe they are a superhero and explain why you have chosen them.
