### Communication, Language and Literacy, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Physical Development, Literacy, Maths, Understanding the World, Expressive Arts and Design

This week our topic has been Around the world! The children have learnt about continents and had great fun going on imaginary journeys in Europe, Asia and Africa. They have looked at climate, mountains, rivers, animals and important landmarks in different countries. They observed and discussed similarities and differences in the way people live their lives in these places and how their schools are different to ours.

In our Maths sessions, children learnt about time; they ordered events in a school day, explored different lengths of time and learnt to tell the time to o'clock and half past.

On Friday, the children met their new teachers and spent the day in their Year 1 classrooms. During lunch, they had Teddy Bears Picnic alongside their parents and current and future teachers.



In Phonics, both groups are now recapping the sounds they have learnt this year. The children have been writing sentences by dictation, reading stories and playing interactive games. It is very important that the children now read every day at home and also practise writing using the sounds they have learnt.
