### Communication, Language and Literacy, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Physical Development, Literacy, Maths, Understanding the World, Expressive Arts and Design

This week our topic in Reception has been 'Summer!' We have looked at the season of summer, where it falls in the year and how it differs from the other seasons. We have also looked at summer safety, focusing on how to stay healthy and safe in the warmer weather. The children loved using their imagination and writing about a 'trip to the beach'. The children all talked about past experiences, and we hope that lots of them get a chance to visit the seaside over the summer holidays. The children also enjoyed making Pointillism artwork this week, showing great patience when creating their perfect paintings. In maths, this week the children were introduced to Pictographs, creating their own using skittles. The children learnt how to record their data and discussed their findings with their peers. This week we have also recapped time, positional language, and number formation. In Phonics we have recapped some of the trickier sounds the children have learnt. We have also looked closely at phonics reading books, encouraging all abilities to read with confidence and discuss what they have read. We are so proud of how well the children are doing in Phonics and we know they are going to impress their new Year 1 teachers in September.



In Phonics, both groups are now recapping the sounds they have learnt this year. The children have been writing sentences by dictation, reading stories and playing interactive games. It is very important that the children now read every day at home and also practise writing using the sounds they have learnt.
