### **Communication and Language, Personal, Social and Emotional Development and Physical Development, Literacy, Maths.**

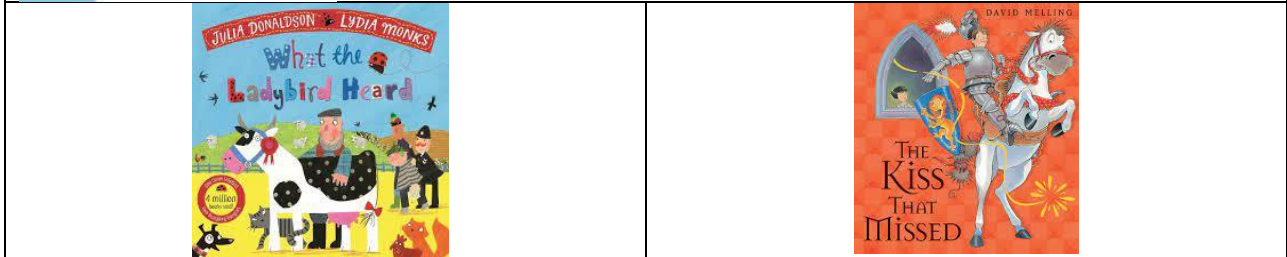
This week's topic was Autumn. The children enjoyed their first trip to the Country Park, observing signs of Autumn. They had great fun trying to find and collect different items on their check lists. Throughout the week the children shared stories about the trip, looked at the picture taken and spoke in the Past Tense. In Maths, they have learnt number five through interactive games and practical activities. On Friday, the children participated in the special Diwali Assembly alongside their older peers, and they marked Remembrance Day by listening to The Poppy Story, designing poppies and holding two minutes silence at 11 o'clock.

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


