Each sound that has been taught in Reception has a fantastic Monster Phonics story that encourages the children to read the



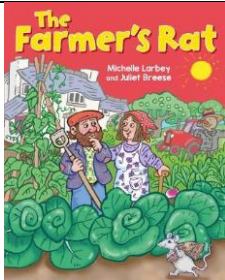
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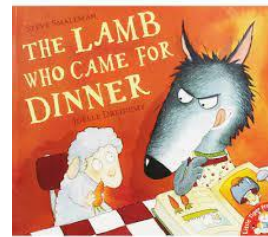
