This week's topic has been "When I grow up..." and the children have enjoyed learning about various jobs and have had discussions about what they want to be when they grow up. Our write away lessons have been based on the topic and each day, the children wrote about a different job. In Maths, we have been recapping counting beyond 20, one more and one less than a given number and number bonds to 5 and 10. On Thursday, the children enjoyed another Musical Bumps session where they have learnt about pitch, beat and rhythm. On Friday, both classes were really excited to release the butterflies that finally hatched from their chrysalises.




Mrs Saftoiu's group focused on the correct spelling of the high-flying words and on the presentation of their written work. The children practiced writing sentences in their best handwriting and using capital letter, finger spaces and full stop.

Mrs Carew's group- Focused on recapping the sounds they have learnt. The children have been taking part in various activities, searching for digraphs and trigraphs in words and

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sentences and reading, using their segmenting and blending skills.
