Our Learning Journey

This week, our topic has been Superheroes! The children have shown great enthusiasm and enjoyment for this topic. It is always a favourite for every child. The children have enjoyed using their imagination to create their own superheroes as well as thinking about real life superheroes. The children enjoyed listening to the story- 10 rules of being a superhero by Deb Pilutti. On Wednesday, the children loved getting dressed up and being a superhero for the day! Thank you, parents, for the effort you put into supporting that day.

In Maths this week we have continued with our class consolidation lessons. In Robin class, we have continued to focus on numbers beyond 10. This week, paying close attention to writing the numbers 11-20 and identifying the pattern in the numbers: 1 and 1, 1 and 2, whilst embedding their understanding that the 1 represents 10.



In Wren class we have learnt to recognise patterns of odds and evens, to subitise to 5 and add and subtract numbers within 10.

On Monday morning next week, we have the **Oasis Academy Ryelands Dance Festival!** Join us on the MUGA as EYFS, KS1, Lower KS2 and Upper KS2 perform their group dances! You won't want to miss it! These dances are Olympic themed, therefore, Mrs Lula (PE lead) has asked that children wear the Olympic ring colours, so dig out something **yellow**, **red**, **blue**, **green** or **black!**
